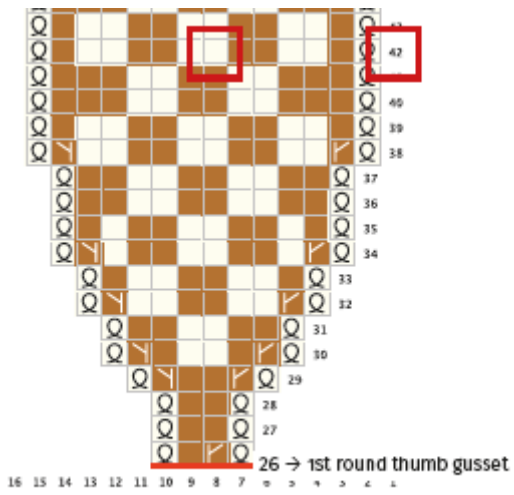
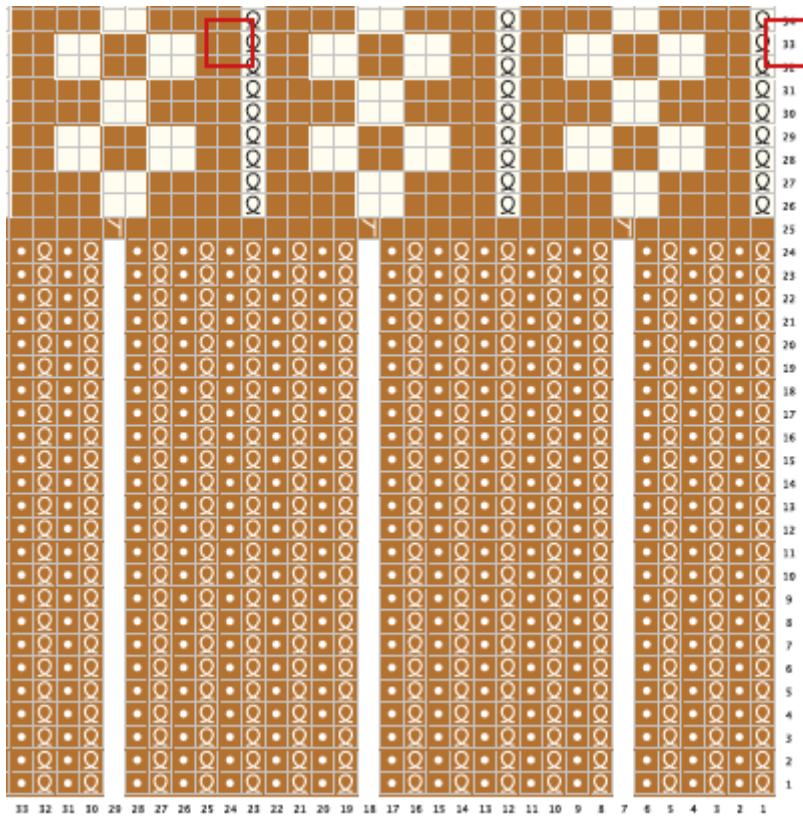


# Errata

## Page 132, 133 (Halla)

### PATTERN NOTES

- See the section about techniques, page 17, for special techniques concerning yarn dominance, decreasing, increasing, and finishing.
- All stitches are knit stitches unless specifically noted otherwise.
- Both mittens are knitted from the same chart.
- Read all chart rounds from right to left.
- The thumb is worked at the beginning of the round on the right mitten and at the end of the round on the left mitten.
- When knitting cuff pattern, the beginning of the round moves 1 stitch to the right on every increase/decrease round. To manage this you slip the last stitch of each knit round and move it to the beginning of the round (to the left needle).

**CUFF** With smaller needles and MC, cast on 60 stitches. Arrange evenly on the needles (15 stitches on each needle) and join into round. Move stitches between needles as needed.

Work cuff with wave pattern as follows: 8 rounds with reddish brown, 5 rounds with dark brown, 4 rounds with grey, and 2 rounds with white.

**Round 1:** Knit.

**Round 2:** [K2, sl2k1pss0, k4, yo, k1, yo, k2] x 5.

**Round 3:** Knit until 1 stitch is left, sl1.

**Rounds 4:** Move slipped stitch from last round to beginning of round on left needle. [K2, sl2k1pss0, k4, yo, k1, yo, k2] x 5.

**Rounds 3–18:** Repeat rounds 3 and 4.

**Round 19:** Knit.
